Welcome to Peggy's Cove!

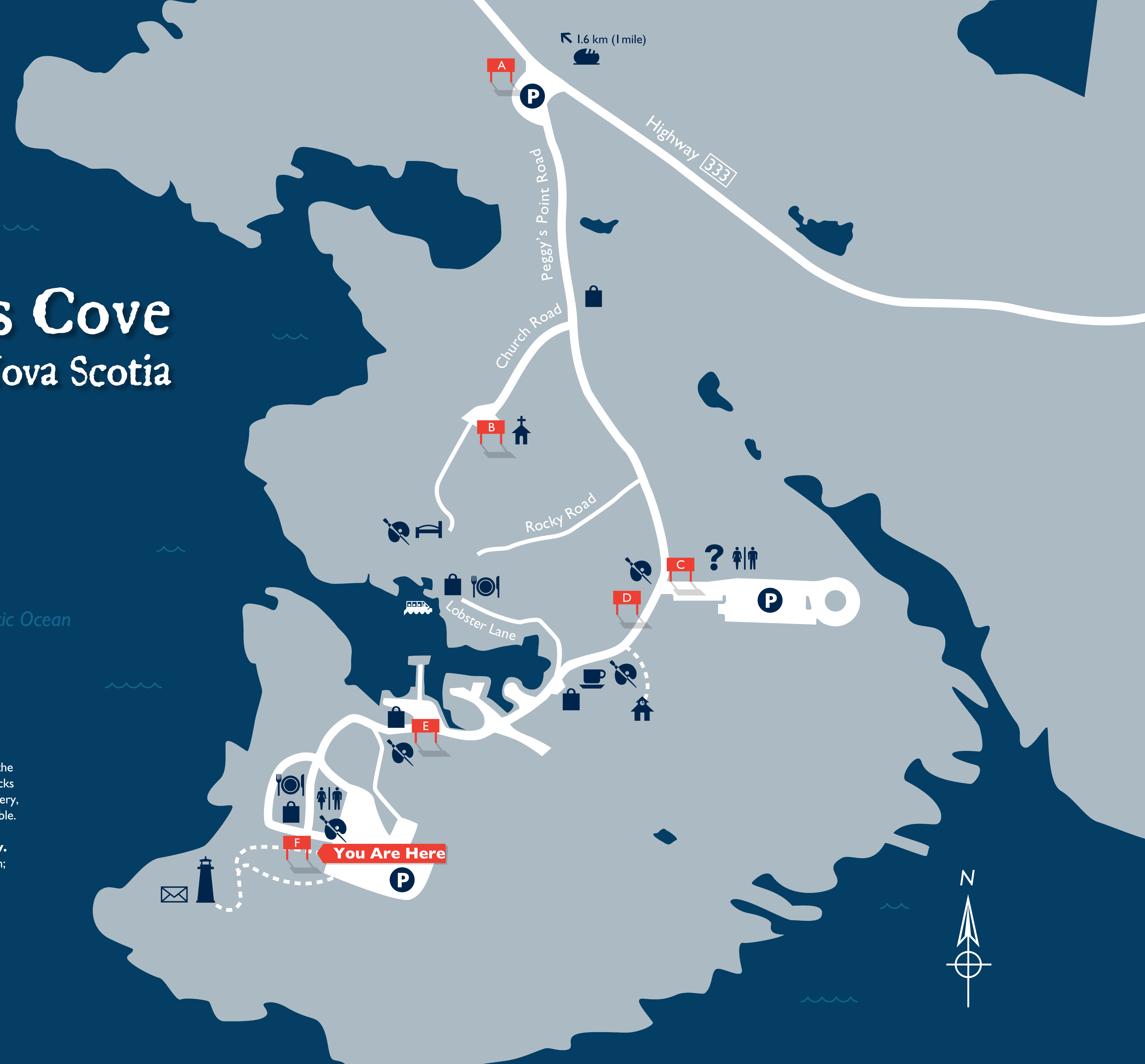
We hope you will enjoy your time here with us and that you will visit us again soon.
